All participants of the COST Action MP0902 “Composites of inorganic nanotubes and polymers” (COINAPO) and other researchers interested into nanocomposite materials are invited to the Workshop of all 4 Working Groups of the Action, which will be held on April 18–19, 2012 in Prague, Czech Republic. Registration and get-together party will take place in the evening of April 17.

COINAPO was kicked-off in November 2009 and currently comprises about 50 research groups from 26 countries. The main aim of the COINAPO is to generate fundamental knowledge in the field of inorganic nanotube–polymer composites and to create widespread links needed for application and commercialization of this kind of composites by European industry.
